

HOW TO USE THE FOLLOWING BUDGET PLANNING WORKSHEET

Section A-Direct Costs:

Tuition and Fees: to figure annual amounts use the above chart x 2.

Lab Fees: only students who are taking specific courses will incur these fees.

Total Estimated Costs: Total the above items and write in the amount

Section B- Gift Aid: List the different awards on the appropriate line.

Amount owed after Gift Aid: Subtract your Total Gift Aid from Total Estimated Costs. If entire costs are paid with gift aid, loans may not be needed.

Section C - Student Loans: Subtract your student loan from the Amount Owed after Gift Aid in Section B.

Amount Owed after Loans: If the Total of Your Gift Aid and Loans are more than the Total Estimated Costs, your balance will be covered by the Financial Aid you are receiving.
