SCHOLARSHIPS

How do I know if I'm eligible?

- ❖ Applicant must be a U.S. citizen, permanent resident, or international student.
- ❖ Applicants must have a high school diploma, GED, or have completed the Ability to Benefit.
- ❖ College students must be enrolled at least half time or plan on enrolling at FVCC for the upcoming academic year (2010-2011) and have a cumulative 2.0 or higher grade point average (G.P.A.).
- ❖ Previous scholarship recipients need to reapply each year for scholarships.

How do I apply?

- ❖ Complete the attached application form.
- ❖ Attach a current academic transcript. (official or unofficial)
- ❖ Attach a 1 to 2 page essay discussing how your FVCC education will help you achieve your educational goals, discuss what your educational goals are, explain your need for scholarship support and give a brief account of your activities, community support and employment.
- ❖ Attach two letters of recommendation, including one letter from a faculty or staff member. The second letter should be from a community member, employer, family friend or other non-relative who knows of your qualifications and character. If you are not a current student, both letters can be from a non-relative.

- ❖ **Applications must be received by 5pm on March 15th for priority consideration. Applications received after March 15th will be considered for any additional scholarships that become available.**
- ❖ These scholarships are awarded for the 2010-2011 academic year. Additional scholarships are advertised and awarded on a semester by semester basis.
- ❖ If you have any questions regarding the scholarship application, please contact the Financial Aid Office at (406) 756-3849.
- ❖ The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) must be filed for financial need scholarships.
