CE-203 Early Childhood Enrichment Ideas

This class will present math, reading and writing ideas for parents to use with their children ages 5-8yrs. Activities are developmentally appropriate and may enrich home school settings or public school activities.

CE-100 & 101 Morning Hatha Yoga

This class will introduce students to Hatha Yoga physical exercise. The Yoga postures exercise every part of the body; stretching and toning the muscles and joints, the spine and entire skeletal system. Postures also work on the internal organs, glands and nerves. Students must have their own mat and wear comfortable clothing.

CE-200 Beginning Oil, Pastel & Watercolor

Basic elements of drawing, color, design and painting as the student learns the use of materials and techniques. Encouragement is given to individual style and expression. Bring set of oil paints, dry pastel or watercolors, set of brushes, 18" x 24" canvas or canvas board (if choosing oil paint), or 11" x 14" sketchbook (if choosing pastel).

CE-201 Intermediate Oil, Pastel & Watercolor

Elements of composition and perspective for those who wish to improve technique develop creativity and use their own resource materials to develop individual style and expression. Bring set of oil paint, dry pastel or watercolors set of brushes, 18" x 24" canvas or canvas board (if choosing oil paint), or 11" x 14" sketchbook (if choosing pastel), and /or additional media of students interest.

CE-202 Creative Writing

A four-week class directed at helping individuals find their own unique and personal writing voice. Students will work on observation and description, self-disclosure, and personal narrative. I believe everybody has things to say, things they know, and this will simply be a class to help them find the courage and confidence to tell their own personal truths. We will do observation exercises and creative visualizations in class and focus as much as possible in the present moment. This class will not emphasize memoir-type writing; rather it will be primarily based on freeing the writer's unique voice.

CE-204 Family Frugal Living

This class will be an open forum to discuss ideas for stretching a family dollar. Home organizational planning, meal planning, and thrifty ideas will be discussed. Bring an idea (or more) of what frugal ideas are working for you.

CE-205 K9 Spring Tune-up

This class is a four-hour dog obedience class in the park. It will be on two separate Sunday afternoons for two hours each to work on basic obedience and socialization. All dogs are required to be on six-foot leash. We will work together on patience and social submission. We will also introduce or polish K9 skills and manners as appropriate and work on our handler skills. Come ready to enjoy the day.

Dress for the weather and come prepared to walk your dog.

CE-300 Intro to the Internet & Email

This course will provide an overview of the Internet and the basics necessary to safely begin accessing the resources of the Internet and Email. Class is designed for seniors or those who have little or no knowledge of the Internet or Email.

CE-301 Intro to Computers

This course is designed for seniors or those who have little or no knowledge of computer operations. It will provide an overview of the computer and the basics necessary to begin using Windows and word processing software, and how to create, save, delete, copy, move and locate files on your computer.

CE-400 Metalworking

A metalworking class which will include casting aluminum and metal machining operations necessary to complete a project. The metal lathe, vertical milling machine, surface grinder, drill press and metal band saw will be used. Students will make an aluminum casting using sand molding and will machine parts so a completed project can be assembled. Machine operations will include turning, facing, drilling, threading, and surface grinding.

Creative Writing for Middle School Students

This class offers an opportunity for middle school students to engage in creative writing activities. This will be a time for fostering an enthusiasm for writing, demystifying the creative process, and improving their confidence in their ability to write.
