Students applying for admission into The Honors Program at FVCC are required to demonstrate evidence of academic capability and motivation by providing:

1. Application to FVCC (see www.fvcc.edu/admissions/steps-to-apply/);
2. Application to The Honors Program at FVCC (see www.fvcc.edu/honors/);
3. 600-word personal statement;
4. Letter of reference from a core teacher, counselor or someone knowledgeable of the applicant's capabilities;
5. Brief statement highlighting academic goals and career plans;
6. Copy of high school/college transcript with current GPA (3.4 or higher recommended); and
7. Documentation of one of the following:
 - ACT composite score of 27; or
 - Before 2016, SAT composite score of 1600; After 2016, SAT composite score of 1270 or higher (reading/writing & math); or
 - Compass scores: reading—95, writing—95 and college algebra—40.
 - FVCC Placement Scores: reading—22, writing—Level 13, introductory algebra—55, intermediate algebra—70

** The above criteria will be evaluated on the basis of the applicant's overall merit. These criteria are not absolute, however, and all highly motivated students are encouraged to apply.*
