Call for Submissions

Showcase your work!

Flathead Valley Community College is now accepting submissions to its new academic journal from all departments, disciplines, and genres.

Submission guidelines:

- Submissions are open to FVCC students, staff, and faculty.
- One submission is allowed per person in each of the genres listed to the right; however, contributors will only be published in one genre.
- Submissions should be submitted in a Word document. Please ensure your name and contact information appear on each page. All submissions must be typed and double-spaced with the exception of poems, which may be single-spaced. Photos may include necessary spatial considerations. Cover letters are neither required nor suggested.

Nonfiction & Scientific Inquiry

Students, staff, and faculty at FVCC are driven, curious people who are performing research and presenting new ideas that the campus community wants to hear about!

- Submit essays, articles, and research papers inspired by your studies. Tell us what motivates you to keep searching out new things.
- Submissions should be 2,000 words or fewer.
- A references or works cited page must be attached if you are citing from outside sources, but you do not need to include that page in your word count.

Fiction

We are interested in a range of stories, so long as the storyline is strong, the characters are interesting, and a lot of explosions aren't needed to keep things moving along.

- Send us your best short story or short play script.
- Submit no more than one story or play per submission.
- A length of 2,000 words or fewer is a good goal.

Poetry

We are looking for poems that move outside the simple constructs of rhyme and meter to show us fresh perspectives. This does not mean that meter and rhyme are unwelcome, but demonstrating these techniques should not be the writer's only goal.

- Submit no more than four poems per submission and no more than one poem per page, although a single poem may be longer than one page.

Art

FVCC students, faculty, and staff produce a range of beautiful, fascinating, and unique artwork, and we are pleased to accept work from art and photography students for publication.

- Photographs and photos of artwork should be submitted as a JPEG image no larger than 2MB.
- If your work is selected for publication, we will contact you for a high-quality photograph.
