Classes offered:

Intro to Computers

Gain a comprehensive understanding of the Windows Operating System and Microsoft Office 2013 - word processing software, spreadsheet software and presentation software. Understand how to store data, manage files and folders, print from and use Internet Explorer. Build your keyboarding skills to an efficient level of speed and accuracy. Increase your knowledge in formatting various business documents, and learn how to setup simple reports and papers for college level English classes.

Intro to College Writing & Grammar Review

Learn the rules of English grammar, sentence structure and mechanics. Move from writing effective paragraphs to longer essays and papers. Become familiar with performing research and writing with a purpose.

Intro to College Math & Algebra

Review basic math skills and introduce algebraic concepts. Learn mathematical symbols, vocabulary and how to use a graphing calculator. Using an online homework platform, apply these tools to functions and graphing concepts critical to success in college level math classes.

Classes meet twice weekly for six to eight weeks.
