When to report ?

Are you worried about a student who:

- Is withdrawn from activities or interests;
- Acts out, is disruptive or displays threatening behavior;
- Has severe changes in appearance and/or hygiene;
- Has concerning writings (e.g. grudges, threatening remarks, or morbid thoughts);
- Is intimidating or exhibits illogical thinking;
- Has preoccupations or actions that could harm self or others;
- Abuses substances;
- Brings relationship issues into the classroom or work;
- Shows self-injurious behaviors; or
- Shows suicidal risk with a refusal to access counseling services?

FVCC BIT's mission is to promote a safe and productive learning, living, and working environment by addressing the needs of students through coordination and assessment of information and developing a supportive plan.

The team meets weekly to review reports that are received about student behavior and determines the best course of action to support the student and intervene before the behavior escalates. If you sense something that does not seem right, the team asks that you say something to a member of the FVCC BIT team or do something by submitting a report online.

Tips for dealing with a concerning student:

- Always keep safety in mind as you interact. If you feel there is any danger, call 911 followed by the FVCC Campus Emergency Line at 270-4555.
- Do not promise confidentiality.
- Do not assume that the person is only trying to get attention or relief from responsibility.
- Document all interactions.
- Know your limitations.
- Know that you do not have to serve as a counselor.
