ACTION ITEMS:

- Approval of October 25, 2019 minutes, p. 1-3 **APPROVED**
Jim Boger moved to approve the minutes; motion passed unanimously.
- Electronics Technician Tier I CTS revision, p. 4 **APPROVED**
Peter Fusaro explained the proposal to revise this certificate. Jim Boger moved to approve the proposal; motion passed unanimously.
- Geospatial Technology CTS revision, p. 5-9 **APPROVED**
Jim Boger explained the proposal to revise this certificate. Sharon Nau moved to approve the proposal; motion passed unanimously.
- Machinist Technician Tier I revision, p. 10-11 **APPROVED**
Peter Fusaro explained the proposal to revise this certificate. Stephanie Paidas moved to approve the proposal; motion passed unanimously. Jessica Hopkins mentioned that the CAS and AAS in this program are called "Industrial Machine Technology," which is different from the title of the corresponding CTS.
