

Flathead Valley Community College and Residence Life are dedicated to implementing updated cleaning protocols to maintain a clean environment for students who choose to live on campus during the Novel Coronavirus pandemic. As you can imagine this is a challenging task and requires diligence on the part of everyone, including residents. Please plan to help us by doing your part in keeping your living spaces clean and complying with the CDC guidance on COVID-19 spread prevention (covering coughs/sneezes, regular hand washing, physical distancing, wearing a face covering, etc.).

By choosing to live on campus, I agree to abide by all CDC, campus, local, state and federal laws, orders, ordinances, policies, regulations, and guidance adopted by FVCC for the well-being of the community and staff members. We thank you for your cooperation in helping keep the FVCC community healthy and safe.

This includes, but is not limited to the following:

- *I understand that a face covering/mask is required to be worn when inside Founders Hall and other campus buildings. This includes all common spaces, lobbies, restrooms, and when visiting other student's apartments. The only exception to this requirement is when a student is in their own apartment.*
- *I understand that unless/until governmental health authorities and the College approve social gatherings, I will not be able to have guests or visitors in Founders Hall in order to support social distancing.*
- *I understand that the Custodial Staff will clean and sanitize the community restroom, all common spaces, and lobbies on a daily basis. During the scheduled cleaning times, I understand that I am unable to utilize these spaces.*
- *I understand and agree that if I develop symptoms of COVID-19, I will refrain from attending work, classes, etc. and that I will stay in my room unless it is absolutely necessary to leave. I will complete the COVID-19 Self-Report Form.*
- *I understand that I will follow all guidance and directives from local health officials, which could result in a self-quarantine or self-isolation on campus.*
- *I understand and agree that if a roommate becomes ill with COVID-19, I will need to follow guidance by the FVCC, Residence Life and health officials, which will likely include quarantining in-place for 14 days.*
- *I understand that I may be required to be tested for symptoms of COVID-19 (temperature checks, nasal swabs, etc.) and provide test results to Residence Life in order to support the safety of the community.*
- *I understand that I have contracted for a housing space and not a specific room. If circumstances arise, such as closing a floor, I may be re-assigned to an alternate space.*
- *Within guidance from local health authorities, all students living on campus are encouraged to avoid, traveling and large crowds 14 days before moving into Founders Hall as well as during their time residing in Founders Hall.*
- *I understand that I will not be eligible for a refund of housing rental rates if Founders Hall were to close, access is restricted during the term, or if the length of the Agreement is adjusted.*

FVCC is committed to supporting our students in their return to campus during this unprecedented time and recognizes the value of the on-campus residential experience. The above requirements and information have been provided to allow students to make an informed decision about living in residential housing for the 2020-2021 school year. While the above is intended to provide some detail, there may be additional modifications needed as the year progresses and FVCC tracks the impact of COVID-19 on the FVCC residential community and campus. As always, we will endeavor to update you with timely information about specific health and safety guidance important for the FVCC residential community.

If you (the Student) declines to accept the terms of this Addendum, then you may opt out of living on-campus for the 2020-2021 academic year and will have until January 15, 2021 to submit a [cancellation form](#) without cancellation penalty.
