A. COVID-19 RESPONSE

President Karas noted that according to Board Policy, Chapter 6, Section 60, whenever the Board of Trustees determines that it is necessary to reduce the number of employees because of lack of work or funds, programmatic changes, or under conditions where the Board determines that the continuation of such work is inefficient or nonproductive, the Board may initiate a reduction in force. As the college continues to monitor the covid-19 pandemic and its effects on the operations of the college, the Board is being asked to approve the initiation of reduction in force should the college need to make changes as the covid-19 crisis continues to change. Trustee Kelly Stimpson moved that the Board, due to the COVID-19 pandemic, make a motion to initiate, as needed, a reduction in force in which the President will bring about the necessary programmatic changes in the best interest of continuing essential services to students. Trustee Mark Holston seconded the motion. With no further discussion, the Clerk called for a verbal vote, those responding "yea" included; Stephanie Wallace, Mark Holston, Peter Akey, Lyle Mitchell, Callie Langohr and Kelly Stimpson. The motion carried unanimously with six (6) "yes" votes. It was noted that as the college moves forward with any decisions or reductions in force, the President would notify the Board and campus community.
