



FVCC Disc Golf Course

Open 7 days a week 8am-8pm

Due to weather, the course may not be set up or may be taken down early.

How to Play

- **Object:** Have fun and play the 9-hole course from beginning to end in the fewest throws.
- **Equipment:** Disc golf is played like golf using a flying disc or frisbee.
- **Tee Off:** Tee throws must be released from within the black tee box mat.
- **Lie:** The spot where the disc lands.
- **Throwing Order:** Lowest score on the previous hole throws first. After the throw, the player whose lie is furthest from the hole throws first.
- **Fairway Throws:** Must be made from the lie. A run-up and follow through is permitted.
- **Putt:** Within 10 yards of the target, a player may not step past the lie when attempting a throw.
- **Complete Hole:** The hole is complete when the disc lands in the designated basket.
- **Par:** The suggested number of throws it should take to finish the hole. To find your score, take the number of throws you took on the hole and subtract the par number. If par is 3 and you took 4 throws, your score is 1. If par is 3 and you took 2 throws, your score is -1.

Course Rules

- This course is free to play and a privilege to the community. Please be courteous and limit group sizes. Allow fast groups to play through.
- FVCC is a tobacco, smoking, drug, and alcohol-free campus.
- Altering or breaking of shrubs and tree limbs is not allowed.
- Beware of walkers, runners, and others when throwing near paths.
- Never throw when another group is on the hole.
- Please pack out all trash and pick up any litter you see.
- No motorized vehicles are permitted on the course.
- Dogs must always be leashed. Owners must clean up all dog waste immediately and properly dispose of waste bags. Dogs must be properly licensed, vaccinated, and free of parasites. Aggressive dogs are not permitted – no fighting or biting.
